Day 1: Madrid - Toledo - Granada

Welcome to this adventure through Spain, Portugal and Morocco! Meet with your tour leader in Madrid and head to the first stop, Toledo. Day 2: Granada - Nerja - Costa del Sol

 Breakfast, Dinner  Victoria Beach (or similar)

Today begins with an optional visit to the breathtaking Alhambra. This must-see marvel must be booked in advance - contact us to book. Then, depart for Costa del Sol. Marvel at the Aqueduct Eagle before visiting Nerja, a charming seaside town. Then, head to the captivating coastal city of Malaga. Enjoy an orientation tour and free time before tonight's dinner.

Day 3: Malaga - Ronda - Seville

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Day 5: **Seville - Algarve**

Day 9: **Porto: Free Day**

Alternatively, escape to a hands-on pastel de nata cooking class where you'll unlock the secrets of Portugal's legendary custard tart and enjoy it with Port wine. This evening, consider an optional experience featuring a live Fado show paired with a three-course feast of local delights overlooking the Douro River.

Day 10: **Porto - Ciudad Rodrigo - Salamanca**

 Breakfast, Dinner  Zenit Hall 88 Studios (or similar)

Depart Portugal this morning and cross back into Spain. Stop in the historic city of Ciudad Rodrigo before journeying to the UNESCO World Heritage city of Salamanca for the night. Once there, take a guided tour unveiling the golden architecture and spellbinding tales of this ancient city. This evening, enjoy an included three-course dinner featuring tasty local delights.

Day 11: **Salamanca - Avila - Madrid**

Once in Chefchaouen, get acquainted with the "Blue Pearl" of Morocco on a guided tour and behold the blue-hued houses giving this city its colourful nickname.

Day 15: **Chefchaouen - Fes**

 Breakfast, Dinner  Hôtel Atlas Saiss Fès 4* (or similar)

Journey to the 13-century city of Fes, affectionately called the "Yellow City". With over 9,000 streets, this is one of the world's oldest and biggest urban pedestrian zones. Discover Seffarine Square and the 18th-Century tiled Nejjarine Fountain on a guided tour. Then, visit a local tannery. End the day with a buffet dinner at the hotel.

Day 16: **Fes: Free Day**

 Breakfast, Dinner  Hôtel Atlas Saiss Fès 4* (or similar)

There are options aplenty on this free day, including souvenir shopping, tasting delicious Moroccan delights and diving deeper into the Fes Medina. Alternatively, choose to take a trip to Volubilis on today's optional excursion. Join a local guide on a tour through ancient Roman archaeology before visiting a regional winery for an idyllic lunch and wine pairing.

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Day 17: **Fes - Atlas Mountains - Merzouga**

 Breakfast, Dinner  Auberge La Belle Etoile (or similar)

Travel to the desert today! First stop is Ifrane, also called "Little Switzerland". Next up is a photo opportunity at the expansive Atlas Mountains as the tour travels through Ziz Valley towards Erfoud. Take a drive through the rugged terrains to Merzouga. Enjoy a lively, traditional bonfire before heading to your idyllic desert camp under the desert sky.

Day 18: **Merzouga - Todra Gorge - Ouarzazate**

 Breakfast, Dinner  RS Hotel Karam Palace 4* (or similar)

On the way to Ouarzazate, take a moment to marvel at the mesmerising Todra Gorge with its striking limestone canyons and overhead cliffs. Then, travel to this evening's hotel. Day 19: **Ouarzazate - Aït Ben Haddou - Tizi n'Tichka - Marrakesh**

Explore Ouarzazate with a walking tour highlighting sights like the exquisite Taourirt Kasbah. Then, visit the otherworldly, fortified village of Aït Benhaddou. After, journey through the twists and turns of the Tizi n' Tichka mountain pass, known for its jaw-dropping scenery which delights at every turn. Arrive in Marrakesh and feast on a regional, slow-cooked meat stew called tangia.

Day 20: **Marrakesh: Free Day**

Start with a locally-guided city tour ticking off top sights like the Koutoubia, Jemaa el Fna Square and various souks. Then, this globally beloved city is yours to explore as you wish. Today's culinary optional excursion is highly recommended to learn more about Moroccan cuisine!

Day 21: Marrakesh: Free Day

Day 23: Essaouira - Casablanca
