Day 1: Start of tour in Cairo

Touch down at Cairo Airport and meet up with a local representative who will assist you through the passport process. Transfer to your hotel and meet up with your passionate Egyptologist tour leader. Sit in on a tour briefing and learn more about the experiences you can look forward to. Get a good night's rest - tomorrow the adventure begins!

Day 2: Giza Pyramids - Sphinx - Sakkara

 Breakfast  Pyramids resort by Jaz (or similar)

After breakfast, join your knowledgeable guide as you set out for the Giza pyramid complex to see the only remaining Ancient World Wonder! Encounter the impressive Pyramids of Giza and the Great Sphinx. Then, enjoy a visit to Sakkara to see the Zoser (also known as Djoser) Step Pyramid - this structure is Egypt's first completed pyramid! Note: The flight to Aswan can be on the evening of Day 2 or the morning of Day 3, depending on flight availability.

- Visit the Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx
- See the Pyramid of Zoser, Sakkara

Optionals:

- Sound and Light Show at Giza Pyramids
- Cairo Nile Dinner Cruise & Folklore Show

Day 3: Aswan - Philae Temple

 Breakfast  Basma Hotel Aswan (or similar)

Arrive in Aswan after the included flight. After checking into the hotel, start the day with a visit to the picture-perfect Philae Temple. Travel to the temple island via motorboat and gaze in wonderment while approaching this beautiful location from the water. This evening, opt to enjoy an authentic Nubian dinner!

Included:

- Explore the Philae Temple

Optionals:

- Dinner in a Nubian House

Day 4: Nile Felucca cruise

 Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  Traditional Felucca (or similar)

Today is jam-packed with adventure! Step aboard a felucca, a wooden sailing boat, and take to the water. Embark on an optional excursion to Abu Simbel this afternoon to explore the mesmerising Sun Temple of Ramses the Great and other impressive remnants of a bygone era. Enjoy an overnight stay on the Nile River felucca boat.

Included:

- Sail the Nile River on a traditional felucca sailboat

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Day 5: Kom Ombo - Karnak - Luxor

 Breakfast  Lotus Hotel (or similar)

Board the air-conditioned vehicle to the city of Luxor. On the way, discover the Kom-Ombo temple with its symmetrical entrances and gorgeous riverside scenery. This afternoon, tour the East Bank of the Nile. Marvel at the immense Karnak and Luxor temples and wander down the Avenue of Sphinxes. Overnight at a hotel in Luxor this evening.

- Discover the Temple of Kom-Ombo
 - Experience the immense Karnak Temple Complex
 - Explore the temple of Luxor
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Day 6: Valley of the Kings - Hatshepsut - Hurghada

 Breakfast, Dinner  Gravity Samra Bay Resort (or similar)

This morning, tour the West Bank of Luxor. Get up close with the rich archaeological heritage of the Valley of the Kings. Then, encounter the majesty of the Temple of Hatshepsut built for Egypt's only female pharaoh. Next, visit the great Colossi of Memnon. Finally, travel to Hurghada, on the Red Sea coast for a stay at an all-inclusive resort.

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Day 7: Hurghada, Red Sea: Free Day

 Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  Gravity Samra Bay Resort (or similar)

Make the most of your free day in Hurghada. Enjoy one of the many activities on offer at the resort. Explore the beach, keep cool in the pool, or simply relax. Alternatively, choose from several exciting optional excursions; why not go snorkelling or scuba diving and experience the region's amazing coral reefs? Breakfast, dinner and lunch are included today.

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Day 8: Hurghada to Cairo

 Breakfast, Lunch  Pyramids resort by Jaz (or similar)

After breakfast, head to Cairo for a day that spans centuries. In Old Cairo, the Hanging Church and Ben Ezra Synagogue reveal Egypt's remarkably layered spiritual heritage, where Christian and Jewish history is etched into ancient stone. Then plunge into the organised chaos of Khan El Khalili Bazaar: incense, copper, colour, and the art of the haggle.

- Visit Hanging Church and Abu Serga Church
- Discover Ben Ezra Synagogue
- Shop for souvenirs at the bustling Khan El Khalili bazaar

Day 9: Cairo: Free Day

 Breakfast  Pyramids resort by Jaz (or similar)

Explore Cairo at leisure today. Choose from the exciting optional excursions, like a trip to Alexandria's scenic seafront corniche. Discover the world-renowned Grand Egyptian Museum's artefacts from Ancient Egypt (it's the largest museum dedicated to a single civilisation). Or, visit the Giza Pyramids for a Sound and Light Show that brings the history of the pharaohs to life.

Optionals:

- The GEM (Grand Egyptian Museum)
- The Sights of Alexandria
- Memphis and Dahshur
- El-Mokattam Hill and Monastery of St. Simeon
- Sound and Light Show at Giza Pyramids

Day 10: Cairo - Amman

 Breakfast  Al Fanar Hotel (or similar)

After breakfast, transfer to Cairo airport to catch the flight to Amman, Jordan's capital city. Touch down in Amman and meet the local tour representative, who will transfer the group to the hotel and provide an overview of what to look forward to over the next few days! This evening, enjoy free time to spend as you wish.

Day 11: Amman - Jerash - Petra

 Breakfast, Dinner  La Maison Hotel Petra (or similar)

Start today with a city tour of Amman. Visit the Amman Citadel, the Roman Theatre and tour the Amman Panorama Art Gallery. Later, head to the Roman city of Jerash. This destination has been inhabited since the Bronze Age and is one of the best-preserved Roman sites outside of Italy! Afterwards, travel to Petra. Arrive and settle into the hotel.

Included:

- Tour Amman, Jordan's capital city
- Explore the Roman city of Jerash

Day 12: **Petra**

 Breakfast  La Maison Hotel Petra (or similar)

Enjoy a fully guided day in the grand city of Petra, one of the New 7 Wonders of the World. Stroll through the winding Siq canyon, where 1.2km of towering sandstone builds to the breathtaking reveal of the Treasury, one of the most iconic rock-cut tombs on earth. End the day among the Royal Tombs, ancient mausoleums carved into cliffsides.

Included:

- Discover the famous Red Rose City of Petra
- Walk through the Siq
- Visit the Treasury
- Explore the Royal Tombs

Day 13: **Petra - Wadi Rum**

 Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  Beit Ali Lodge Camp (or similar)

Leave Petra behind and travel to Wadi Rum, where the landscape shifts into something almost otherworldly. Vast sandstone mountains, rust-red dunes, and a silence that feels ancient. As the sun sets over the desert, settle into your traditional Bedouin-style camp and spend the night under one of the most spectacular skies you'll ever sleep beneath.

Included:

- Sleep in a Bedouin camp in Wadi Rum

Day 14: **Wadi Rum - Madaba - Mt. Nebo - Dead Sea - Amman**

 Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner  Al Fanar Hotel (or similar)

After an early breakfast at camp, travel to Madaba to see its remarkable 6th-century mosaic map of the Holy Land, still intact in the Greek Orthodox Church of St. George. Then head to Mount Nebo, where Moses is said to have first seen the Promised Land, before floating in the legendary Dead Sea and returning to Amman for an included dinner.

Included:

- Explore Mount Nebo
- Swim in the Dead Sea

Day 15: **Amman**

 Breakfast

Make your way to the airport after breakfast. Today is the final day of your Egypt and Jordan tour and we hope you enjoyed a wonderful journey. Say farewell to your tour mates and return home with wonderful memories. See you back on tour soon!
