Day 1: Start of tour in Helsinki (New Year's Eve)

Day 2: Helsinki: Free Day

This morning, journey towards the Latvian capital. En route, stop in the Estonian resort town of Pärnu. Arrive in Riga and visit the Latvian Military Cemetery to uncover WWI history. Then, check into the hotel before embarking on an orientation walking tour, including must-see sights of Riga's Old Town like the Dom Cathedral and the House of the Black Heads.

Day 5: Riga - Hill of Crosses - Vilnius

Arrive in Vilnius, Lithuania's vivacious capital, and embark on an orientation tour. Discover the UNESCO-listed Old Town with its Baroque architecture and more than 700 years of history. Day 6: Vilnius - Trakai - Gdansk
