Day 1: Start of tour in Copenhagen

 Dinner  Moxy Copenhagen (or similar)

Arriving in the afternoon, soak up Tallinn's unmatched medieval atmosphere with lunch at a historic restaurant in the Old Town square. Then, join a local guide on a walking tour of this fairytale city's striking spires, colourful houses and incredible viewpoints.

Day 14: **Tallinn - Pärnu - Latvian Military Cemetery - Riga**

First stop is the Latvian Military Cemetery, a national monument honouring over 2,000 Latvian soldiers.
